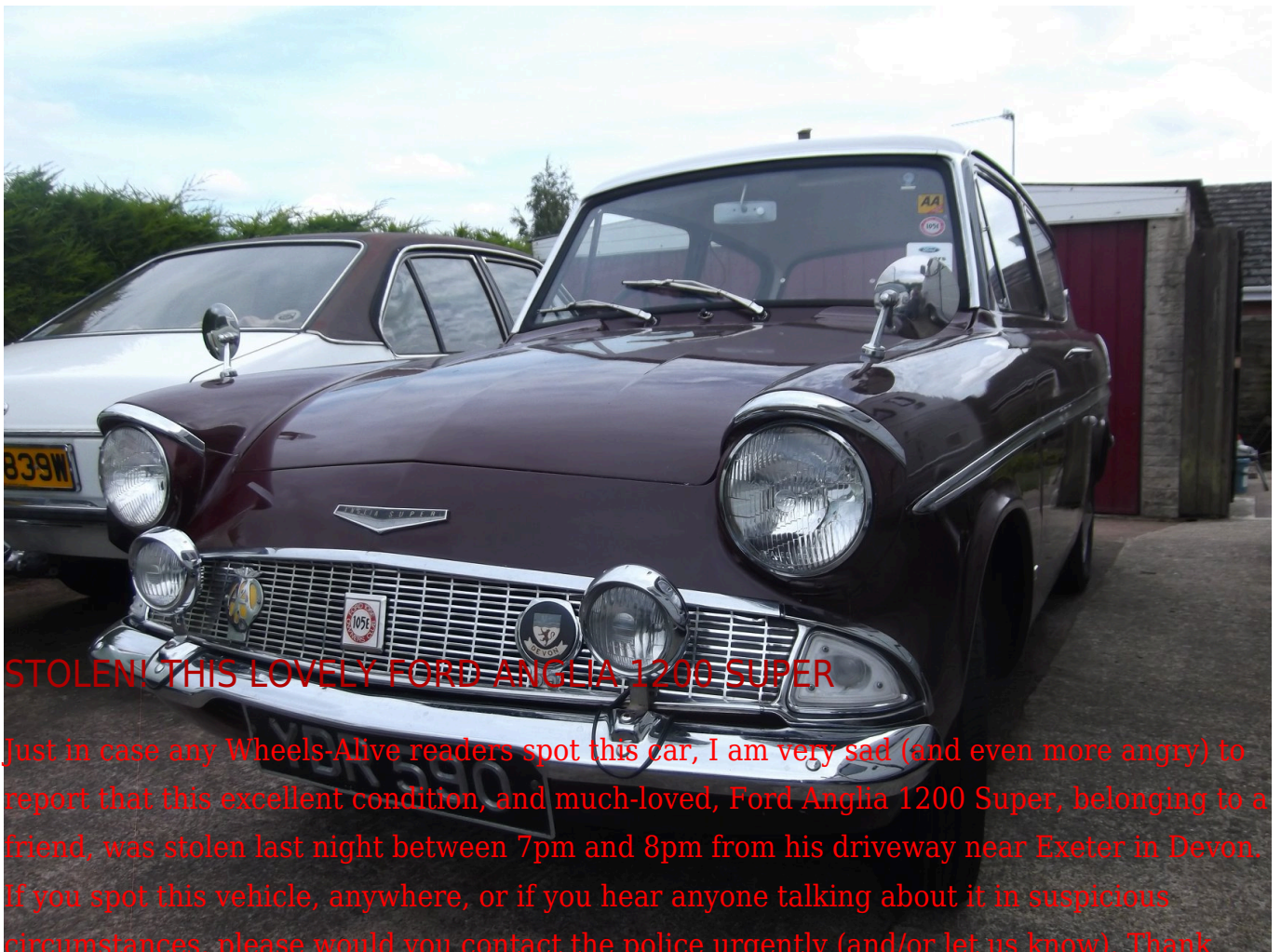

Meanwhile if you have a classic of your own, it would be worth reviewing any security measures that you have in place, or upgrading them as a matter of urgency. Unfortunately there have been many cases recently of classic vehicles being stolen from around the country...

As a first step if your classic has to be kept in the open, if you have a modern vehicle with relatively sophisticated security features, and that can be parked such that the classic is 'protected' by it, consider doing this.

Another approach would be to install a security post or barrier across the entrance to the parking area/driveway; at least this might deter 'casual' thieves.
