During the last weekend in May this year, the Austin A30/A35 Owners' Club held the

This year the event marked and celebrated 70 years since the introduction of the A35 in the summer of 1956 (this updated model replacing the the innovative A30, first revealed to the public in 1951).

Owners and enthusiasts of the A30 and A35 models drove from far and wide to attend the Rally, which happily took place with dry weather throughout. Owners of other classic makes and models were in attendance too, making for a varied and fascinating line-up of vehicles.

This included awards for aspects such as 'the waggiest tail', etc. Evening events included a quiz and live music.

For those who wished to stay on site, camping was available.

Food, drinks and ice creams were on offer to all throughout the event.



The Club's well-attended AGM, held at the Rally, provided the chance for members to have their say about admin. Matters, which were discussed in some detail.
