One of Beaulieu's best-loved events, Spring Autojumble, will be returning on  $14^{th}$  and  $15^{th}$  May, taking its rightful place in the packed events calendar after a two-year absence.

Following in the tyre tracks of International Autojumble, which successfully returned to the Beaulieu parkland in 2021, the show will combine colourful car displays and hundreds of bargain-filled stands, for a busy motoring-themed weekend that everyone will enjoy.

As part of the event's triumphant return, impressive car club displays will be amongst the show highlights. Rare examples of the lilac-painted Morris Minor Million will be on show in *Moggyfest*, a packed display of Morris Minors and contemporary classics brought together by the Dorset branch of the Morris Minor Owners' Club.


