



Planned Circuit of Wales to be home to the world's largest action centre

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Extreme Sports Company has confirmed it will open the world's largest action centre at the proposed Circuit of Wales site near Ebbw Vale.

While Welsh Government has yet to decide if it will back the Circuit of Wales motor sports complex, Extreme chairman and CEO Alistair Gosling, Chairman and Chief Executive of Extreme, said they have a master-plan in place to introduce their facilities once the go-ahead is given.

Proposed facilities include Mountain Bike Trails, BMX Park, Indoor Ski, Trampolining, Skatepark, Virtual Reality Zone, Surf Park, Live Music Stages and much more, accompanied by two new hotels and a campsite.
