The family-friendly event is also accommodating to those with access needs. We look forward to hosting another successful event in April!"

Vehicle exhibitor tickets cost just £13 per adult and include entry for the car and a driver. Exhibitor passenger tickets cost £13 per adult and £7 per child. Tickets give admission to the show, Museum and Collections Centre.

Museum entry is just £18 for adults in advance or £21 on the day, £16 for concessions in advance or £19 on the day, £9 for children (5-16 years) in advance or £10 on the day and under 5s are FREE. There is also the option to Gift Aid or donate your entry fee and get an Annual Pass in return at no extra cost.
