Graham King's bronze-coloured Ford Escort Mark I two door saloon, registration UFX 365L, was stolen on April 12th, 2022 from a private driveway in Wallisdown, east Dorset, and it is believed that it was taken in the early hours of the morning.

Graham is appealing once again for any clues, and is offering a substantial reward for genuine information leading to safe recovery of the car, which he has owned for many years.

At the time that the car was stolen, it had a car cover on it and a Krooklock was fitted, also the passenger front seat was not installed.
