The new look website - www.nationalmotormuseum.org.uk - reflects the Museum's new brand identity and uses fresh new photography and pages of articles and inspiring multimedia content to share the Museum's famous collections of vehicles and motoring memorabilia.

Additional pages allow supporters of the Museum to discover more about its educational and restoration projects, enable the public to make online donations, to



book tickets for National Motor Museum events, and, before long, to join the Friends of the National Motor Museum Trust and the patrons of Beaulieu 100, and to create an account for easier renewal and updating.

Jon Murden, Chief Executive of the National Motor Museum says, “Our new website is a step-change in engaging with our audiences. Its fresh new presentation allows us to showcase our new brand and gives our supporters, potential visitors and enthusiasts access to a huge online resource.”

The National Motor Museum’s new website was developed using the Umbraco Content Management System by the museum’s team working with Southampton based web developers Semantic.
